Daytrail in Syöte National Park

The half-hour drive from Syöte to the Rytivaara Loop Trail is well worth the trip! While hiking the trail, you'll be able to experience the full beauty of Syöte, from its traditional farmsteads to the magnificent wide open expanses of bog meadows.

The Rytivaaran kierros Circle Trail is an ideal day hike, both for a grade schooler with a passion for nature and for senior citizens wanting to relive the wanderings of their younger days. The Rytivaara Crown Tenant Farm outdoor museum offers a lot to see and do on a warm summer day. Visitors can just flop down in a pristine meadow and take in

the sun, take selfies with the local sheep, draw water from a well using an old-fashioned well pole and roast sausages in the front yard of the farm. On the way back, you can fill your basket with mushrooms and berries. Chanterelles have even been seen at Rytivaara.

**OPEN:** June- Oktober.**TRAVEL TIME:** 4 h.

CHALLENGE LEVEL: The trail is intermediate. There are some climbs and descents and the trail can be rocky and criss-crossed with roots in some places.

**START AND FINISH:**

Ukonvaara parking area, Karsikkoperäntie 1591.

**EQUIPMENT:**

For variable terrain, you should wear sturdy waterproof shoes, such as all-terrain runners or walking boots. Clothing: Weatherproof hiking clothes. In the day pack: a drink, a picnic, spare clothing, rain gear, a rubbish bag, a first aid kit, a charged phone and a map. To light a fire: matches and a knife. Bring your own toilet paper.

**SAFETY:**

- In case of emergency, call 112.
- Reserve enough time to detour the route

- There are no waste containers and no waste management at the national park. Food waste can be placed in the outdoor toilets.
